A bumbling maintenance crew finds a magical yellow bird and a mad chase begins!

Racing over land, across the sea, and through the air – battling pirates and monsters – how far will our heroes go... without ever leaving the maintenance room?

Join Liars & Believers on an adventure of masks, puppets, and gibberish.

In Yellow Bird Chase, we transform gloves, mops, buckets, and sheets into camels, cars, pirates, boats, and (of course) birds.

With the audience as our co-conspirators, we turn the rules of reality upside down. Yellow Bird Chase reveals to audiences the power of their own imagination.

Yellow Bird Chase is appropriate for ages +2 and fully accessible to Deaf audiences.



Tech

Yellow Bird Chase is a flexible show that has toured to festivals, theatres, schools, and parks. It can play in a bright room, on the grass, in the street, or in a fully functioning theater.

We use minimal sound and lighting.
Our set loads into a space in 20 minutes.

Basic technical information

50 min with no intermission (35 min for young children)
3 Actors I technical staff
Basic lighting plot or open room with full light
Basic sound PA with input for ipad if available
Minimum playing space: IO'w x IO'd x 9'h to the lights
